

SKEET WINTER LEAGUE 2010-2011

The league begins Sunday, December 12 with registration at 9:00 AM. It will run for 10 consecutive weeks, excepting we will skip the Sunday after Christmas, December 26. The fields will open for shooting at 10 AM and will close at 2:00 PM. This means that shooters should have finished their skeet league shooting for the day by 1:45 PM. Shooters are encouraged to shoot in the morning as the fields are less crowded early on.

500 targets are to be shot over the 10 weeks. On average, each shooter will shoot, then, 50 targets each week. However, a shooter may shoot a week ahead if he or she knows he will not be able to shoot the following week, or ***1 week back if a date was missed- to "catch-up." More than a week back, and that week will be forfeited. Note that this is a change from previous years.*** Forfeited matches will be scored as the lowest score an individual has shot, plus his or her handicap. This is intended to encourage the completion of all matches to maintain a competitive league, and to avoid some score-keeping challenges we have had in past years. Scoring will be based on your best 7 of 10 scores. In other words, your 3 lowest scores will be dropped at the end of the league to determine final standings. A shooter must complete 7 weeks of the league to qualify for prizes. For individuals, there are both straight average and handicap competitions. The handicapping system is explained elsewhere.

In addition to the individual competitions, there are team competitions. Shooters are encouraged to form their own 4 man teams for scoring, but team members do not have to shoot shoulder to shoulder. If you do not form or join your own team, you will not be assigned to one.

This year, you can shoot 28g or .410g with a handicap. However, you must complete all 50 league targets for that day with that gauge once declared (note that you can legally change gauges from week to week.) The handicap is 28g: 1 target per 25; and, .410g: 2 targets per 25. ***Note, too, that a pump in 12g, or 20g will get a handicap of 1 target per 50, and a pump in 28g will get an additional handicap of 1 target per 50, so that the total handicap for a 28g pump will be 3 per 50. There will not be any additional handicap for a .410 pump, so that the total handicap for a .410g pump will be 4 targets per 50- the same as for a .410g in any type of shotgun.***

The \$25 entry fee is payable at sign-up. Weekly charges for 50 targets are \$4 skeet committee, \$8 all other members, \$12 guests. These fees include end of league prizes and banquet. Our banquet will be separate from that of Sporting Clays, and is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, March 20, 1:30 PM at our clubhouse.

In the RARE CASE that the league is cancelled due to bad weather, a notice will be sent through email. If you don't have email, contact someone who does. Cancellation may or may not be made on radio station WICC (600 AM).
